Conference theme and venue

The Symposium will start on June 23rd and last until June 28th, 2019. Sessions will be held in the oldest building of the Jagiellonian University in Kraków and cover topics ranging from fundamental and applied particle, nuclear and atomic physics, through radiotherapy and medical imaging to healthcare, following the spirit of the Jagiellonian Symposia to bring together excellent scientists from diverse fields. The symposium will be held at the Collegium Maius of the Jagiellonian University ([Jagiellońska street 15](#)) in the very centre of Kraków.

A map of the Krakow City centre is included at the last page of this circular.

The city of Kraków, cultural capital of Poland and economic capital of its southern region, is a lively university city with many historical buildings. It has a rich cultural life due to the many art galleries, theatres and high-profile festivals. The city centre offers excellent shopping and a diverse night-life.

Scientific programme

The regular sessions of the symposium will take place in general from 8:30 to 18:30 every day between Monday, June 24th and Friday, June 28th. The detailed programme of the conference is available at the symposium homepage.

Presentations

Every day the scientific session will start with a keynote talk given by a notable expert followed by the invited, standard and short presentations. The scheduled times for the talks are 35 (30+5), 25 (20+5), 20 (15+5) and 15 (12+3) minutes respectively. The speakers are kindly asked to arrange their contributions accordingly. The presentations have to be provided in electronic form in one of the formats: Portable Document Format (*.pdf), Microsoft Office (*.ppt, .pptx) or OpenOffice/LibreOffice (*.odp). All speakers are kindly requested to upload their presentations either to the Indico web system or to the conference computer (by contacting the technical personnel available in the lecture hall) before the session for which their talk is scheduled.

Poster session

The poster session will start on Tuesday at 13:35 and last until 15:15, followed by the announcement of winners of the poster contest. There are three prizes foreseen for the three best posters chosen in a voting by the participants. Every participant is allowed to vote for three posters except for participants affiliated to the organizing department. The ballot cards for voting will be attached to the conference badges. The poster size should not be greater than A0 size (**portrait - 33.1 x 46.8 in**).

Public lecture

On the evening of Wednesday, June 26th (at 19:00) in the Gallery of 19th-Century Polish Art, *Sukiennice*, a special public lecture

[The Sukiennice gallery is located at the very centre of the Main Square in Krakow.](#) The hall where the public lecture will be held is on the 1st floor with an entrance on the south-eastern side of the building (presented in the photograph). The entrance is labeled “*MUZEUM NARODOWE*”.



Social events

- 1) The symposium will be preceded by a Welcome Reception, which will take place on Sunday, June 23rd between 17:00 and 19:00 in the Collegium Maius of the Jagiellonian University, the same location where sessions will be held. **The registration desk will be open during the reception.**
- 2) The Classical Music Concert will take place on Monday, June 24th at 19:00 in the Assembly Aula of the Collegium Maius.
- 3) Conference barbecue dinner will be held in the historical building of *Collegium Barnium* located in the very centre of the Czułówek Village, at 19:30 on Friday, June 28th. A bus will be provided to take the participants to the barbecue venue from the centre of Kraków. The assembly point for bus transport will [be in front of the Collegium Maximum building \(Krupnicza street 33 .\)](#). The bus departure is scheduled at 19:00.

Guided tour

The guided tour to the Jagiellonian University Museum located in the building of Collegium Maius (conference building) will be arranged after the welcome reception between 18:00 and 19:00.

Lunches and coffee breaks

Lunches will be served each day of the meeting in the restaurant “Gościenna Chata” located at [Sławkowska street 10](#). Please refer to the map on the last page of this circular for the directions for reaching the restaurant from the conference venue. Coffee breaks will be served in the room close to the hall where sessions will be held.

Conference photograph

A conference photograph will be taken on Wednesday June 26th in the courtyard of Collegium Maius between the morning sessions and lunch.

Visits to the J-PET laboratory

Participants wishing to take a tour of the Jagiellonian Positron Emission Tomograph (J-PET) laboratory are encouraged to contact the organizers. Visits will be organized on an individual basis during the Symposium.

Participation questionnaire

In order to ensure best organization of the events, we would like to kindly ask you to revise the participation questionnaire filled during registration. If your plans for attending particular sessions and events have changed since the registration, you can update the participation questionnaire by logging in to the [Indico conference system](#) and choosing the “Modify” option in the “Registration” tab.

Registration and Conference Fee

The registration desk will be open each day of the meeting from 8:00 until the last presentation. Conference desk will be located near the entrance to the lecture hall. **Please note that at the registration desk the conference participation fee or guest house accommodation charges can be paid in cash only.** The conference fee includes the welcome reception, lunches, guided tour, conference barbecue, coffee breaks, social events, conference proceedings and other administration costs. The proof for the fee and accommodation payments will be provided at the conference desk. In case of special requirements (e.g. fiscal code) to be included in the proof of payment please let us know in advance via the conference email address.

Proceedings

The proceedings from the symposium will be published as regular articles in Acta Physica Polonica B (<http://www.actaphys.uj.edu.pl/>). **The deadline for submission of contributions to our Indico system is September 1st, 2019.** The page limits for different types of contributions are the following: a maximum of 10 pages for keynote talks, 6 pages for invited talks and 4 pages for contributed talks and posters. All the submitted contributions will undergo a review.

Arrival and travel to the city centre

To come from the Kraków Balice Airport to the city centre (Kraków Główny - main bus and train station) you can use either a train service, public bus transportation, or taxi service.

We recommend to use the train as the fastest way to get to-/from the airport (the journey to the city centre takes about 17 minutes). Trains are equipped with air conditioning, power outlets, Wi-Fi and ticket machines. All trains also have spaces for disabled passengers and persons with reduced mobility (PRM). The ticket price to the Kraków Main Train Station is 9.00 PLN (around 2 Euro). The luggage can be taken free of charge. The ticket can be purchased at the ticket machine in passenger terminal, level 0 (cash payment or payment with credit/debit card), ticket machine at train station (cash payment or payment with credit/debit card), train conductor on board (cash payment in PLN only). All trains operate 7 days a week and the time table is available at <https://malopolskiekoleje.pl/index.php/pierwsza-strona>. There are two available bus lines: 252 and 208, connecting airport with the city centre (though not strictly with the main station). The travel time to the centre by bus is approximately 40 minutes. Tickets for this bus may be purchased at newspaper stands (RELAY) in the passenger terminal and also at the ticket machine in the bus. The single trip ticket price is about 5.00 PLN (**the ticket has to be validated after entering the bus!**). The taxi operator at the airport is the "Krakow Airport Taxi Service". The travel time to the city centre is about 20 minutes. Price ranges from 50 to 100 PLN depending on the distance and time of the day. 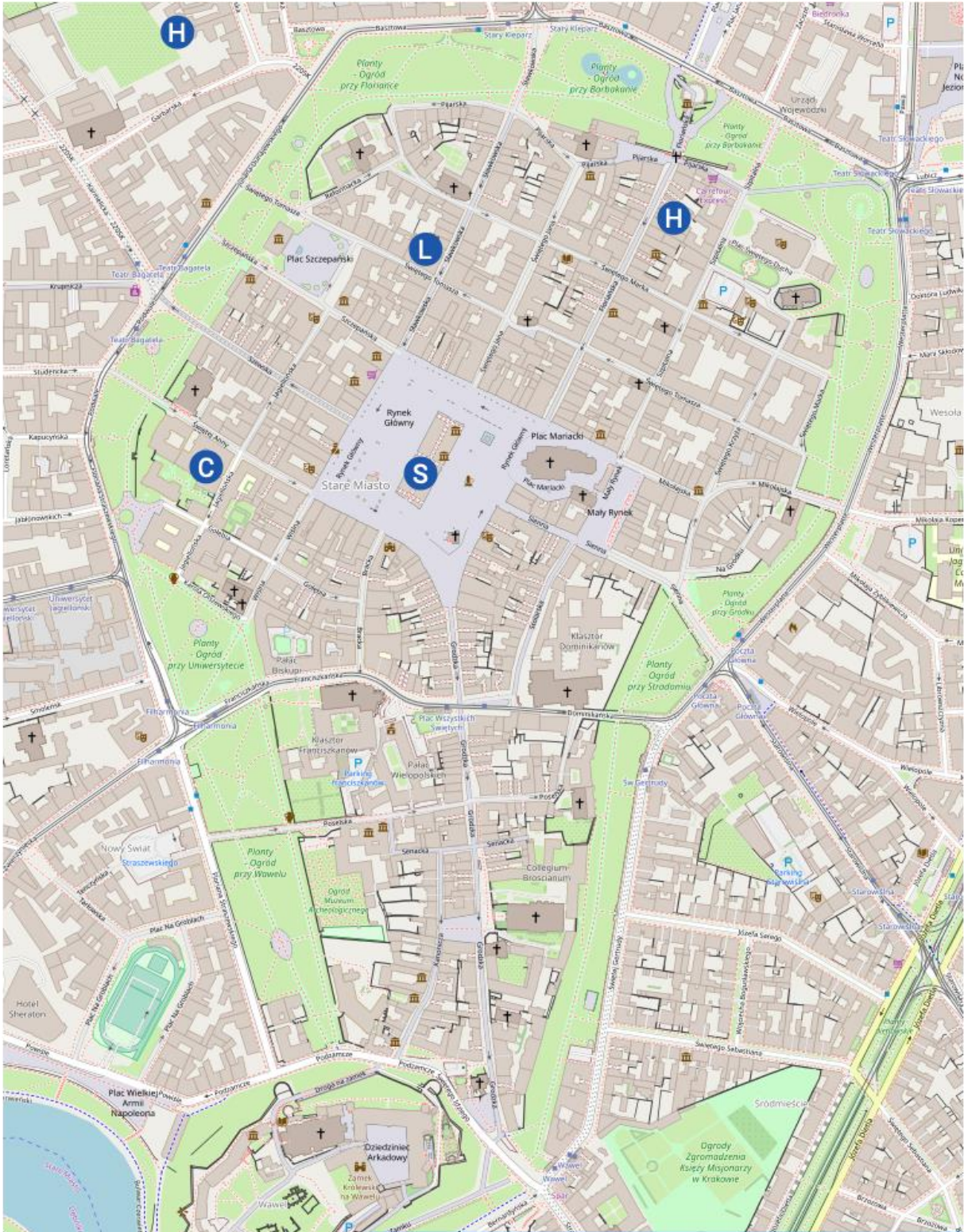
